Tasks include finding interesting topics for an article, reaching out to colleagues who may contribute to an interesting article, writing and/or adapting articles (topics can be very broad, ranging from the Dutch language, to translation, interpretation, technology, language-related research, literature, etc.).
- Of course, more is always welcome! If you are an avid blogger and writer, love sharing interesting tidbits about the language industry and the Dutch language, this is the place to 'leave your egg' (waar je je ei kwijt kunt).
- Are you a novice blogger or writer? Don't worry! Your colleagues are always available to proofread articles and give you guidance or feedback, if needed.
