- 3. Minutes of 2023 annual meeting (held on September 22, 2023) -- shown and approved
- 4. Overview of the last 12 months
 - ATA TEKTalks: quarterly series with one special feature episode, total of 5 episodes since Q4 2023, total of 2,041 registrations, tools featured: BWX, Custom.MT, XTM, Metalinguist, Boostlingo, Q&A format with industry leaders behind the tools, FREE to all ATA members
 - ChatLTD Digital Socials: September 2023, February, March, April, May, June, Summer 2024, LC members taking turns leading the sessions, prompts for discussion based on recent publications, FREE to attend
 - ChatLTD Networking Dinner at ATA64: 39 attendees, DS, other speakers, sponsors, exhibitors, Slator
 - ChatLTD Breakfast Club at ATA64: our second year, focused on MTPE/AI, held on two mornings during the conference
 - ChatLTD Professional Forum at ATA64
 - ChatLTD badges circulated at ATA64
 - ATA64 programming: 26 sessions listed under Technology for Language Professionals, 2 sessions by Distinguished Speaker Don DePalma from CSA Research (*The New Dawn of Translation Quality, Language Professionals in the Era of Omnipresent Generative AI*), Daniel and Bridget posting about sessions on social media in weeks leading up to the conference
 - ATA65 programming: LTD leaders involved in vetting session proposals submitted to Conference Organizer, happens every spring
 - The ATA Podcast, Inside Specialization: Opportunities in the Era of AI with Konstantin Dranch
 - ATA Chronicle: Language as a Technology (group effort), Getting Started with ChatGPT to Boost Your Productivity (Daniel)

- Response to ATA's <u>Statement on AI</u> (published in November 2023, LTD not consulted) -- our positive yet pragmatic/realistic <u>Guidance</u> rejected by the Board in July 2024, but led to creation of AI Task Force
- #NoLinguistLeftBehind: campaign to better explain the motives behind our generally pro-technology efforts, it could be part of a broader member-retention and member-recruitment campaign by HQ / ATA's Membership Committee
- Interpretation Policy Advisory Committee (IPAC): Bridget representing LTD
- Media inquiries: Daniel and Bridget serving on ATA's PR committee and fielding media inquiries pertaining to language technology, <u>NPR article</u>, TIME interview eventually not published
- Website: articles about ATA TEKTalks episodes, ATA65 content, announcements about events throughout the year
- Social media activity: all channels listed on <u>our website</u>, most activity on Groups.io, some activity in LinkedIn and Facebook groups, very limited activity on public Facebook page, Instagram profile, X handle, YouTube channel
- Member newsletter: sent out by HQ monthly
- Leadership Council: growing steadily (from 12 wonderful individuals at this time last year to 16 today, with several more observers/candidates), monthly meetings, 2 of our LC members are running for President-Elect this fall
- LC member activities: Viktoryia was interviewed for <u>SLD's Slovo podcast</u> on topics including AI, another <u>Slovo episode</u> on AI with Bridget and Daniel
